Curtain Wall / Deck Coating SCHEDULE TR 1



Update: As the project progresses, Tatley Grund is working through the coating and curtain wall/punch list - Please be advised that when the swing stage (and ropes) present outside your deck, the TG team is still working on that stack, and we ask that you NOT use, or be on the deck during working hours 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the duration of the project if the swing stage is present. This is a hazard for anyone to be on their deck for things that may fall and the stage going up and down per necessity of the stack.

- Stacks '09: Residents may place items on your deck if the tape has been removed. However, the swing stage is still in place for the workers for the next 2-3 weeks, please stay off the decks during the day (8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) and Saturday if they chose to have a make-up day. They still need to finish the sides of the decks and curtain wall punch list - this will be for the duration of the swing stage present for the remainder of the project.
- STACKS '00: [Units 1900 and 1000, 2000, 2100, 2200, 2300, 2400 Do not access your deck or place items on your deck - as these decks are primed and being coated]. Residents of all other Units may place items on your deck if the tape has been removed. However, the swing stage is still in place for the workers for the next 2-3 weeks, please stay off the decks during the day (8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) and Saturday if they chose to have a make-up day. They still need to finish the sides of the deck and curtain wall punch list - this will be for the duration of the swing stage present for the remainder of the project.
- STACKS 01 and '02 Deck Primer and coating is being applied- we will advise when the articles can be reset and coating is cured.
