## Curtain Wall / Deck Coating SCHEDULE TR 1



**No Additional Direction:** As the project progresses, Tatley Grund is working through the coating and curtain wall/punch list – Please be advised that when the swing stage (and ropes) present outside your deck, the TG team is still working on that stack, and we ask that you NOT use, or be on the deck during working hours from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the duration of the project if the swing stage is present. It is a hazard for anyone to be on their deck for things that may fall and the stage going up and down as required in order to complete the work in the stack. **Please do NOT remove any of the blue tape on your deck - that with the understanding that the TG team will be back removing the blue tape and addressing the punch list items**

- **STACKS '09:** Please do NOT remove any of the blue tape on your deck - that with the understanding that the TG team will be back removing the blue tape and addressing the punch list items (and carefully navigating through those decks around the furniture).
- **STACKS '00:** Please follow the instructions left on your deck for access]. Furniture can likely be replaced. Please do NOT remove any of the blue tape on your deck - that with the understanding that the TG team will be back removing the blue tape and addressing the punch list items (and carefully navigating through those decks around the furniture).
- **STACKS 01 and '02** – Deck Primer and coating is being applied- we will advise when the articles can be reset and coating is cured.
