The <u>'09, '00, '01, and '02</u> stacks are completed, HOWEVER, RDH AND Tatley Grund are still working through the last of the punch list on these stacks, if the swing stage is still present, please refrain from using the deck until the blue tape is cleared.

Please be advised that when the swing stage (and ropes) present outside your deck, the TG team is still working on that stack, and we ask that you <u>NOT</u> use, or be on the deck during working hours from <u>8:00 a.m.</u> to <u>6:00 p.m.</u> for the duration of the project if the swing stage is present. It is a hazard for anyone to be on their deck for things that may fall and the stage going up and down as required in order to complete the work in the stack.

The swing stage will be in place for the workers for the next 2-3 weeks, please stay off the decks during the weekdays Monday through Friday (8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) and Saturday if a make-up day is required

- <u>Stacks '03</u>: If you haven't already done so, items must be removed from your deck for washing and preparation of the coating.
- <u>STACKS '04</u>: If you haven't already done so, items must be removed from your deck for washing and preparation of the coating.
- <u>STACKS 05</u>: If you haven't already done so, items must be removed from your deck for washing and preparation of the coating.

Once the deck scope of work was initiated there can be no access, even during off-hours. Residents being allowed on the decks during off-hours can/will create issues related to the work such as spilling, pet pee on the deck, etc. That would require re-cleaning, possible adhesion issues, and general quality control issues.

An <u>Excessive Heat Watch</u> will go into effect Friday into early next week. Saturday through Monday there will be "high risk" for sensitive populations.
