TOWER 1 - EXTERIOR SEALANT PROJECT:

<u>Update:</u> The move of the swing stages will be made this week to the <u>WEST</u> Elevation to the '03, 04, and 05 stacks. Due to the hot weather for the crews, we will be informing residents of schedules as they are formed, the swing stages will have to be moved first before deck washing can begin.

The '09, '00, '01, and '02 stacks are completed, HOWEVER, RDH AND Tatley Grund are still working through the last of the punch list on these stacks, if the swing stage is still present, please refrain from using the deck until the blue tape is cleared.

The swing stage will be in place for the workers for the next 2-3 weeks, please stay off the decks during the weekdays Monday through Friday (8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) and Saturday if a make-up day is required. TG team still needs to finish the sides of the decks and curtain wall punch list - this will be for the duration of the swing stage present for the remainder of the project..

STACKS 05: If you haven't already done so, items must be removed from your deck for washing and preparation of the coating.

Once the deck scope of work was initiated there can be no access, even during offhours. Residents being allowed on the decks during off-hours can/will create issues related to the work such as spilling, pet pee on the deck, etc. That would require recleaning, possible adhesion issues, and general quality control issues.
