TOWER 1 - EXTERIOR SEALANT PROJECT:

<u>Update:</u> The move of the swing stages is ongoing to get in place to the <u>WEST</u> Elevation to the <u>'03, 04, and 05</u> stacks. The swing stages will be moved first before deck washing can begin.

The '09, '00, '01, and '02 stacks are completed, though the punch list as well. The swing stage will be moved 7/6 to 7/9, if it is still present, please refrain from using the deck until the blue tape is cleared.

Please be advised that when the swing stage (and ropes) present outside your deck, the TG team is still working on that stack, and we ask that you <u>NOT</u> use, or be on the deck during working hours from <u>8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.</u> for the duration of the project if the swing stage is present. It is a hazard for anyone to be on their deck for things that may fall and the stage going up and down as required in order to complete the work in the stack.

- <u>Stacks '03</u>: If you haven't already done so, items must be removed from your deck for washing and preparation of the coating.
- <u>STACKS '04</u>: If you haven't already done so, items must be removed from your deck for washing and preparation of the coating.
- STACKS 05: If you haven't already done so, items must be removed from your deck for washing and preparation of the coating.
